Examine wildlife art and have a go at drawing unique wildlife artefacts

Year 3-6

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the session:

- ✓ **All pupils** will know how art has been used to document wildlife through the ages
- ✓ **Most pupils** will understand how different mediums can be used to different effects
- ✓ **Some pupils** will be able to show different art techniques (shading, contrasting, etc.)

Session Outline:

The session starts with how art was historically used to describe animals and nature. The session then moves into art from studies leading to art in the modern age, focusing on artists that use different mediums and techniques. The pupils will then have the opportunity to get up close to a number of real furs, skins, feathers as well as replica skulls and other biofacts to draw from observations, in the provided wildlife sketchbooks.
