ZOO HOST ROLE

The Colchester Zoo Host programme provides you with a fantastic opportunity to develop your knowledge of Colchester Zoo, as well as the chance to experience the workings of a zoo environment and share practical information with our guests.

CRITERIA

- From 9:30am – 4:00pm (summer) 3:00pm (Winter) with a hour break 1 day per week.
- Ambassadors MUST be at least 18 years old and over.
Please do NOT apply if you are under the age of 17 years as your application will not be considered.
- Be Available for a minimum of 1 day a week.
- Good organisation skills
- Being friendly and approachable
- Willingness to meet people from different backgrounds
- Excellent Interpersonal skills
- Punctuality
- Working in teams
- Confident in responding to questions
- Willingness to be outdoors in all weathers
- Able to move to all areas of the zoo as the role requires
- Knowledge of the zoo is desirable but not required

ABOUT THE ROLE:

To be a Colchester Zoo Host you should be open, friendly, and enjoy meeting and engaging with new people. You will also need to have a good level of confidence and assertion skills. In your role you will be assisting Colchester Zoo and its visitors in a variety of ways, these are detailed below:

GREETER:

- Provide a warm welcome to our guests at entrance advising them on the days events, best routes and answering any other questions as they arise.
- Providing maps to guests

EVALUATION COLLECTION:

- To provide visitors with a variety of feedback methods; face to face surveys, handing surveys out etc.

SUPPORT PAID FOR GIRAFFE FEEDING:

- Under staff direction manage entrance and queuing at the twice daily giraffe feeds.

ROAMING:

- Patrolling Zoo supporting visitors in accessing facilities and events during their visit and providing information about the Zoo.

- SPECIAL EVENTS:** The zoo provides a calendar of themed events such as Halloween and Magic of Christmas and occasional events. Volunteers are encouraged to support these events where they can and are given briefings to do so.
- TRAINING PROVIDED:** You will undergo a training programme to ensure that you have a good understanding of the role, and that you can carry the role out to an appropriate standard. At the end of training and trial period, we will meet you to discuss the training and any support you may need.
- TRAINING AREAS COVERED:** ZOO VOLUNTEER INDUCTION - History of zoo, role of volunteers at Zoo, emergency procedures, what we expect of you and what support you can expect from us, Role of the modern Zoo and Zoo orientation activity.
