HOW TO USE THIS PACK

This pack is designed for SEND visitors to use with their carers whilst visiting the Zoo.

This is a long trail designed to use the main senses to explore the Zoo A shorter trail is also available to explore the Familiar Friends farm area.

On the next page is a map highlighting the route. Feel free to do the whole trail from start to finish or just pick a page or two to focus on. Please use this resource in whatever way works best for you. Please note this route takes you though most of the zoo and could take up to 4 hrs to complete from start to finish.

On each page there are symbols, which represent the senses. These will indicate which sense or senses will be focused on. Below is a key for these symbols.



HELLO

My name is Opal, the elephant.



Would you like to join me and explore the Zoo? As we go around There will be many smells, sounds, and things to see. Some animals like to hide, lets see what animals we can find. There may be crowds of visitors and Colchester Zoo staff.

Let us start at Worlds Apart which is on my map.



WORLDS APART





This is home to many animals.





I might see frogs, monkeys, iguanas, fish and I might even see a sloth! In some places the path can be dark, but I can still see inside the animals' home.

One of the animals that live here are the poison dart frogs. What do they look like? Are they shiny?



As I go around, I will cross a glass bridge over a pond. I will be safe.

How many fish can I see?

What can I hear as I go across the bridge?







WORLDS APART



On the way out I pass the home of the sloths and monkeys. Sloths move very slowly.

Do I move quicker than a sloth? How many animals can I spot?




There are two doors in and two doors out of the animal's home.

I must close one door before opening the second. This is to keep the animals safe.









ORANGUTAN FOREST





The Orangutan forest is number on my map. To get to Orangutan Forest I need to go through the underwater sea lion tunnel. It may be dark at first but soon gets light again. I may see the sealions above me.





At the end of the tunnel is a microscope. I can use this to see small things up close. What shapes can I see under the microscope?



Once I go through the tunnel, do I feel warm or cold? Can I spot these fish in their tanks?











OUTSIDE ORANGUTAN FOREST



If I go up the big ramp to see the orangutan's outdoor area, I will see an entrance to a special room.

Inside this room there are boxes that smell like foods that are grown in the rainforest.

I can have a go at guessing which foods these are if I would like. Box 1

I can also see the orangutans outside too.


Can I spot the orangutans?

(tip they sometimes like to hide under blankets.)






SEALION TUNNEL AND PENGUINS

Which statues can I see?
















BEARS OF THE RISING SUN



Passed the smelly penguins, there is a large undercover area, where I can see the sun bears' outside home. On the wall are lots of signs where I can learn more and have fun.

MEERKATS



Further down the path, passed the monkeys, are the meerkats. They are number on the map. There is a large meerkat statue which I can touch and take a picture with if I like.

Can I find the meerkat statue?

I can watch the meerkats and see what they are up to. If I can not see the meerkat outside, I can look inside. How many meerkats can I see?

DINOSAUR REALM







Just beside the meerkats is the Dinosaur Realm. I can walk through here if I wish to see the large model dinosaurs and hear all the noises they make. How many dinosaurs did I see?

Can I copy any of the noises the dinosaurs make?



There is a room at the end with interactive activities where I can explore more if I wish.

It can be quite noise in here. If I do not like it I can ask to leave. If I do not want to enter the dino realm I can carry on up the path past the lion and go around.















RAINBOW LORIKEETS





After the dinosaur realm, I can go up the hill to my right and feed the rainbow lorikeets their special food if I wish. I can also walk through with out feeding them if I prefer.

The birds may land on my hand as they eat their food. They may also fly very fast and close to me. If I do not like this, I can ask to leave.

I will hold the pot of food out towards the birds and wait for them to eat. I will not grab or touch the birds. That would scare them.



What sound do the lorikeets make?

The birds can be very loud. If I do not like it I can ask to leave. If I do not want to see the birds I can go straight to the next stop.

I must wash my hand after feeding the lorikeets.










KOI NIWA

If it is not too busy inside, it is nice to sit down and watch the koi fish. This is where the koi fish live.


How many koi fish can I see in the big tank?_____



THE FARM ANIMALS






The next stop is the farm animals which are

What are the birds doing? _____



This is number on my map.




It might be dark in here with some colorful lights.

When I have finished touching the animal, I must wash my hands.

















Outside Kingdom of the wild next to the lake is Aardvark Burrow.

How many aardvarks are sleeping?


Aardvarks smell different to me. I can smell what the aardvark's smell like by putting my nose to the holes.

There may be a queue for the train, and I will have to wait my turn. There may be people I do not know on the train with me.


The train driver will tell me about the animals we go passed using the speakers. It can be quite loud.






Once I reach the lemurs the train driver will tell me what to do. I must listen carefully.

There are also some large model bugs to find. Can I spot all the bugs?












THE END
